CALL TO ORDER

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Commissioner Atkins moved to approve the June 16, 2015, minutes as presented. Commissioner Saunders seconded the motion and the motion passed 6-0, with Commissioners Harrill and Smades having not yet arrived.

<u>DISCUSSION OF MONROE COUNTY SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS PRIVATE</u> <u>STREETS AND PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION REQUIREMENTS</u>

Staff presented the Monroe County Subdivision Regulations requirements for private access easements and the associated property owners' association requirements. A lengthy discussion followed. By consensus it was agreed that private access easements should only be permitted outside the city limits and that rather than calling it a property owners' association, it should be called a private road maintenance agreement. Staff explained that if the commission wished to change the road requirements within the planning region, the County Commission must first approve the change by a 2/3 vote.

Commissioner Harrill moved to proceed with the request before County Commission to redraft the Subdivision Regulations to allow private streets within the planning region. Commissioner Atkins seconded the motion. The motion passed 8-0.

Staff will forward the request to the County Commission to be heard at their August meeting. If approved by County Commission, staff will bring the amendment back to the planning commission for action.
