CALL TO ORDER AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Chairman, Bill Howe called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. The minutes of the March 6, 2014, meeting (the April 3, 2014 meeting was cancelled due to a lack of a quorum) were unanimously approved on a motion by Allen Cansler seconded by Bill Shadden.

SUBDIVISION PLAT, BRAD AND ANGELA MULLINS PROPERTY, TIPTON ROAD, TAX 50, PARCEL 28.04

Although no one was present to represent Mr. and Mrs. Mullins, the planning commission reviewed their subdivision plat. The Mullins' own approximately .81 acres which has an existing single family home. The property is off Tipton Road, with no road frontage. Currently, Ms. Mullins' father, Barney Tipton, owns the adjoining property which surrounds the Mullins lot. Mr. and Mrs. Mullins are acquiring an additional .31 acres of Mr. Tipton's property which has an existing brick garage. The additional .31 acres would make the Mullins property approximately 1.12 acres, but still lack road frontage. The Mullins' access their lot by crossing Mr. Tipton's property which is approximately 51 acres.

Kyle Holder moved to approve the plat which was seconded by Brent Cofer and approved unanimously on a roll call vote

UPDATES AND REMINDERS

There was a discussion regarding the recent policy change by the Register of Deeds, allowing Surveyors to stamp boundary surveys certifying that they were not plats according to the definition of a subdivision in Tennessee Code Annotated.
