CALL TO ORDER AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Chairman Cansler called the meeting to order at 7:11 p.m. immediately following the Board of Zoning Appeals meeting. Commissioner Davis moved to approve the minutes of April 2, 2019. Mayor Lovingood seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

DISCUSSION OF THE VONORE PUBLIC STREET LIST

Hawk presented the Public Street List and reported that she has been working with David Wiggins in finalizing the list. In researching the streets in Tellico Harbor, Hawk found that in 2000 the restrictive covenants were amended to delete reference to the streets being private because they were now public. Sabrena Norris also found in the Board of Mayor and Aldermen minutes in the 1990's where actions were taken by the Board that implied the Town owned the streets. The purpose of creating this street list is to establish a list of all streets the Town owns and is responsible for maintaining. Once finalized, the list will be presented to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen for approval and acceptance. A general discussion followed.

Mayor Lovingood moved to recommend acceptance of the Vonore Public Street List to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen. Commissioner Moore seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.
